


## SAMPLE - Pip and Pap Phonics




These are the new phonic sounds you will meet in this set of books.

Recap the sounds before starting the story.


















There are some words that cannot be fully sounded out and decoded yet.


We call these 'Earth Words'!

Some of these words will start with capital letters if they are used to start sentences.










































## Parent and child activity
