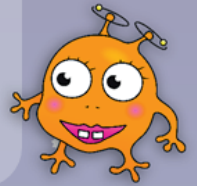


These are the new phonic sounds you will meet in this set of books.

Recap the sounds before starting the story.

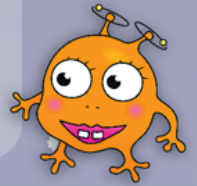


SAMPLE - Pip and Pap Phonics

Dentist

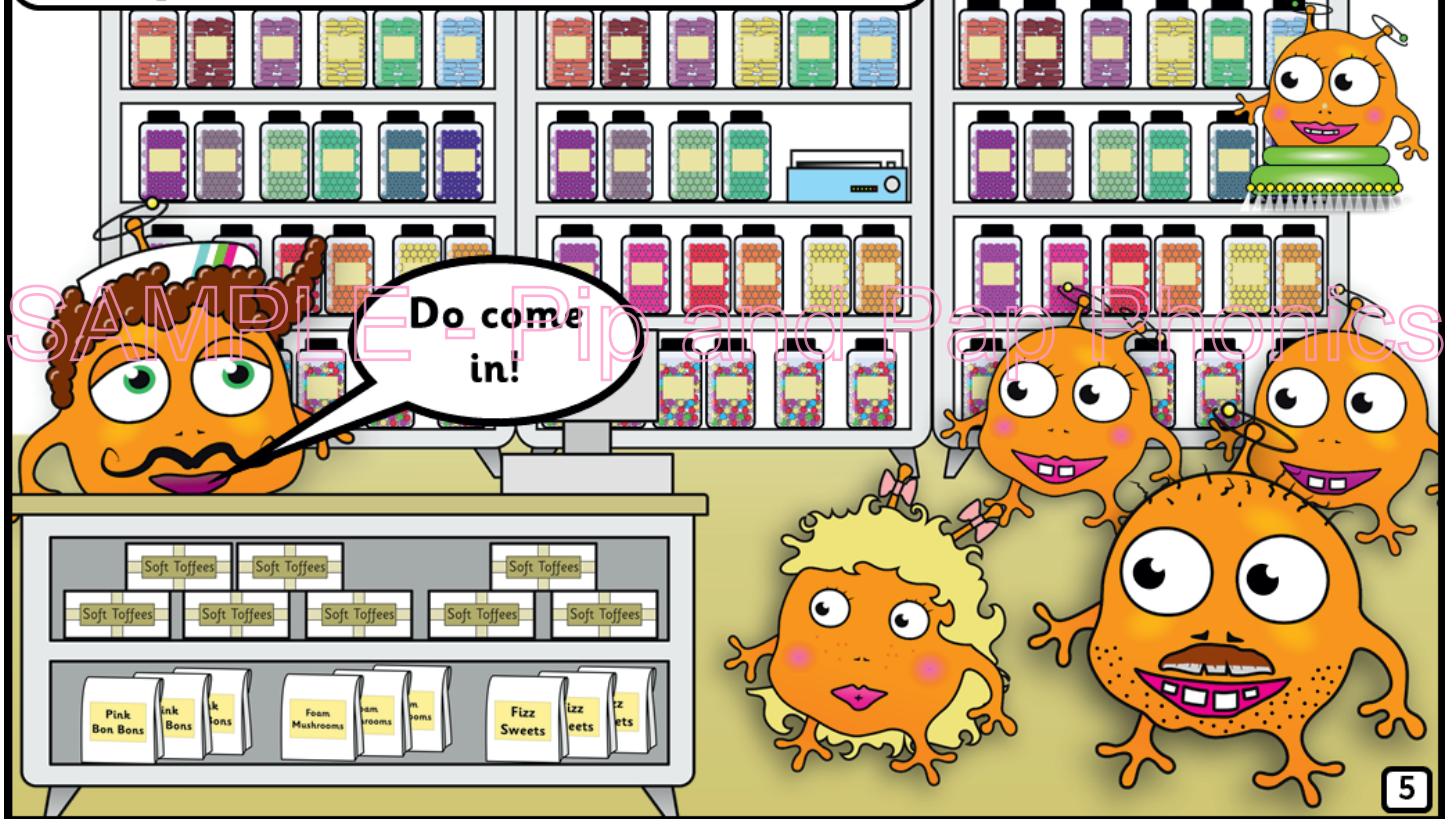
High Street

**You can get one bag.**

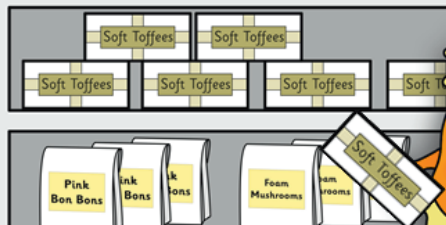
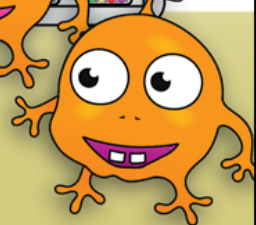
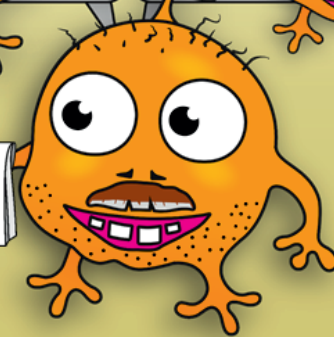
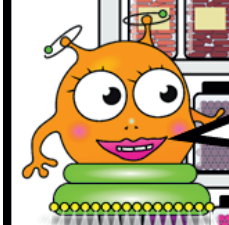


**Min gets a box of soft toffees.**

Pip picks up a packet of pink bon bons.



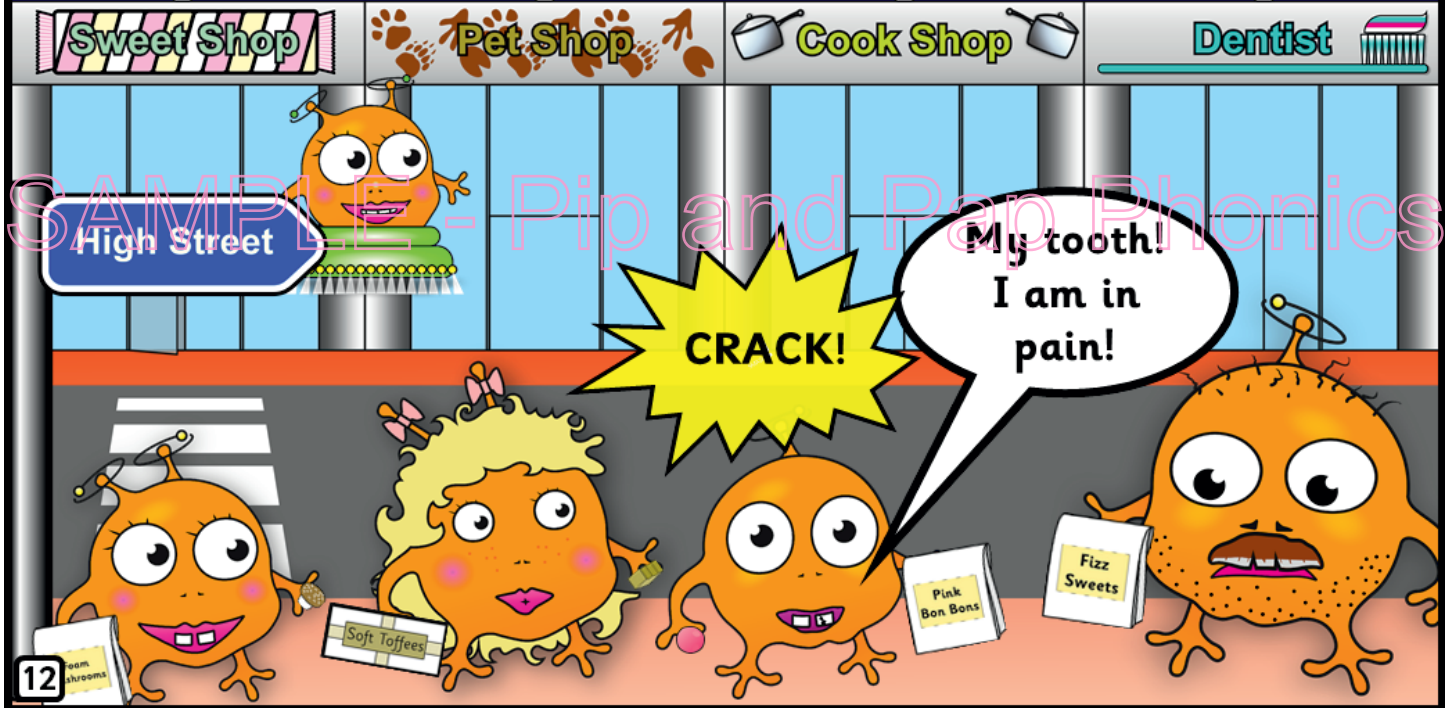
**Dad hands Tweep some cash.

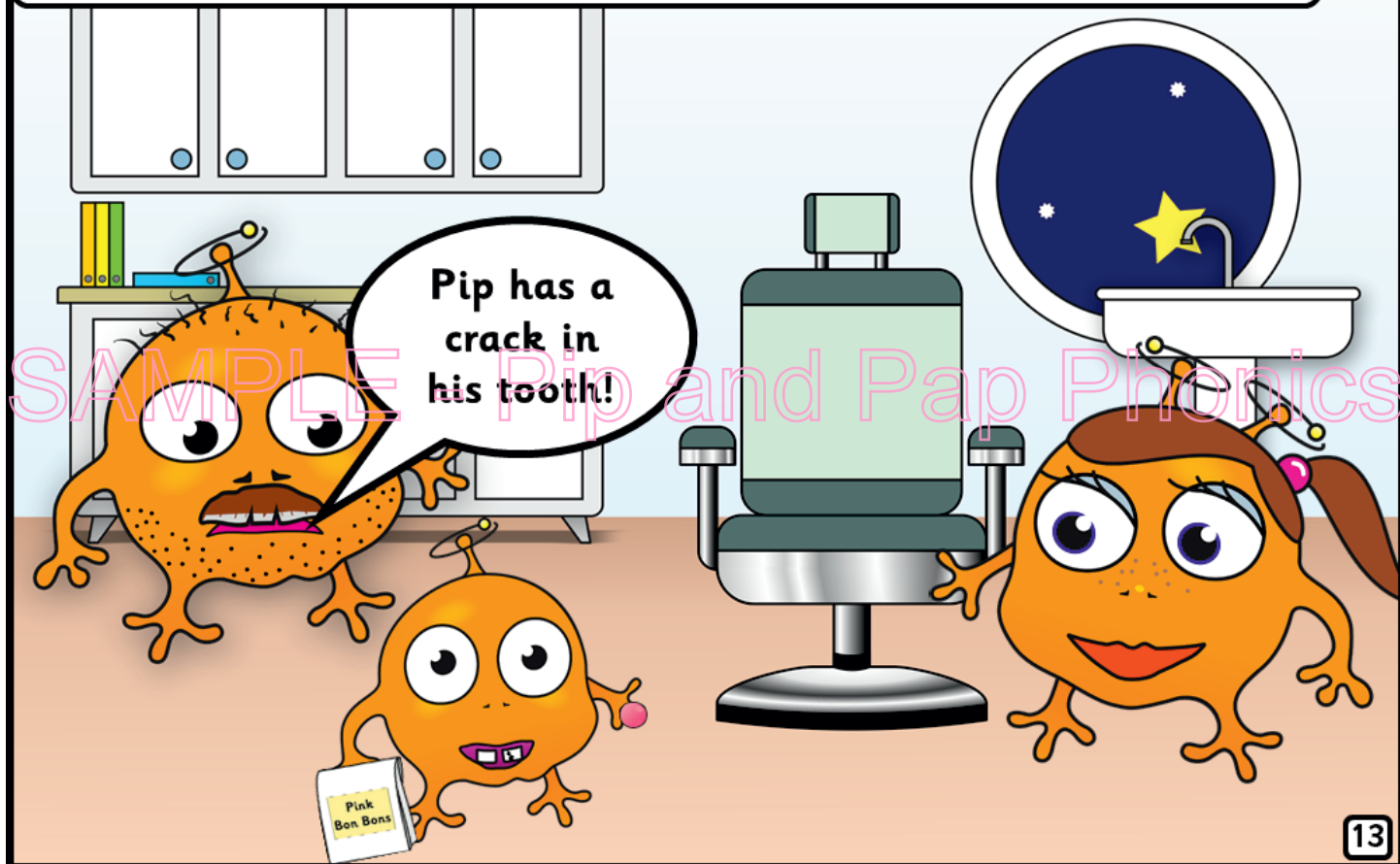

Dad and Pip wait to see Thoot the dentist.



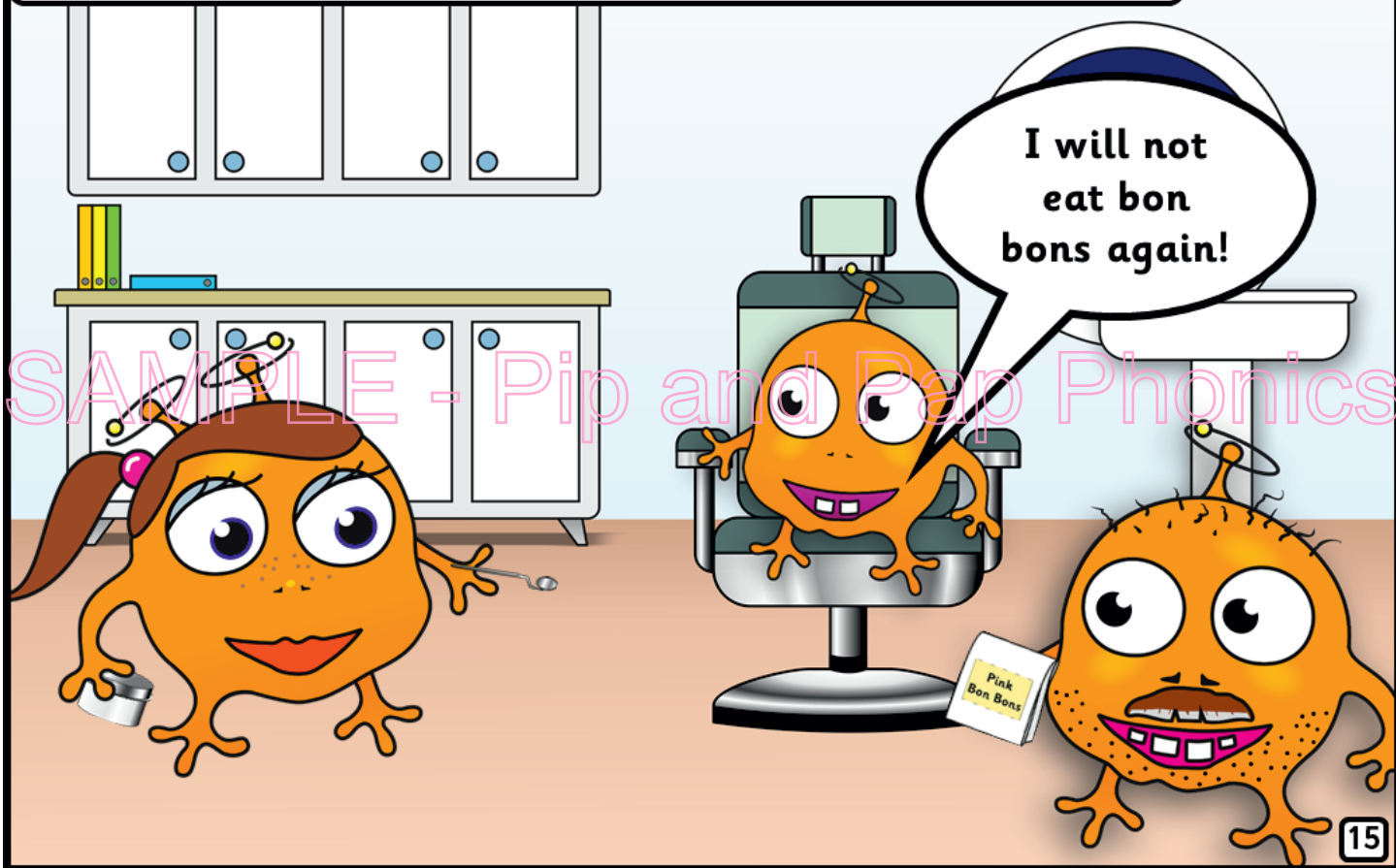
**Thoot checks all of Pip's teeth with a light.

SAMPLE - Pip and Pop Phonics

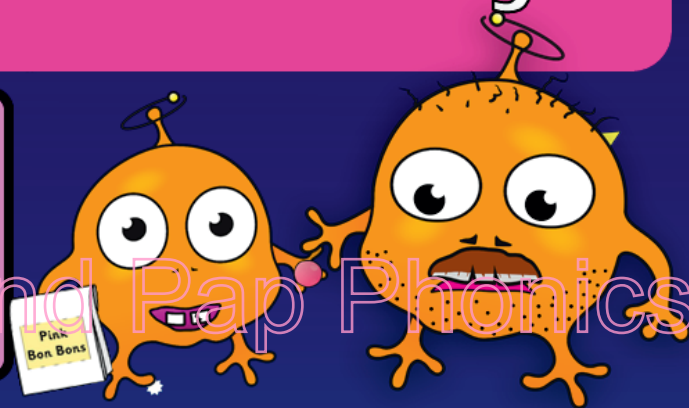


**Thoot fixes Pip's tooth with her tools.**



# Parent and child activity

In this story, the children go to the sweet shop! Pip cracks his tooth on a hard sweet and has to go to the dentist! Thoot the dentist fixes his tooth.

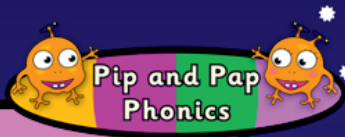
