Recap the sounds before starting the story.

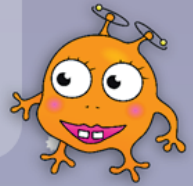


SAMPLE - Pip and Pop Phonics

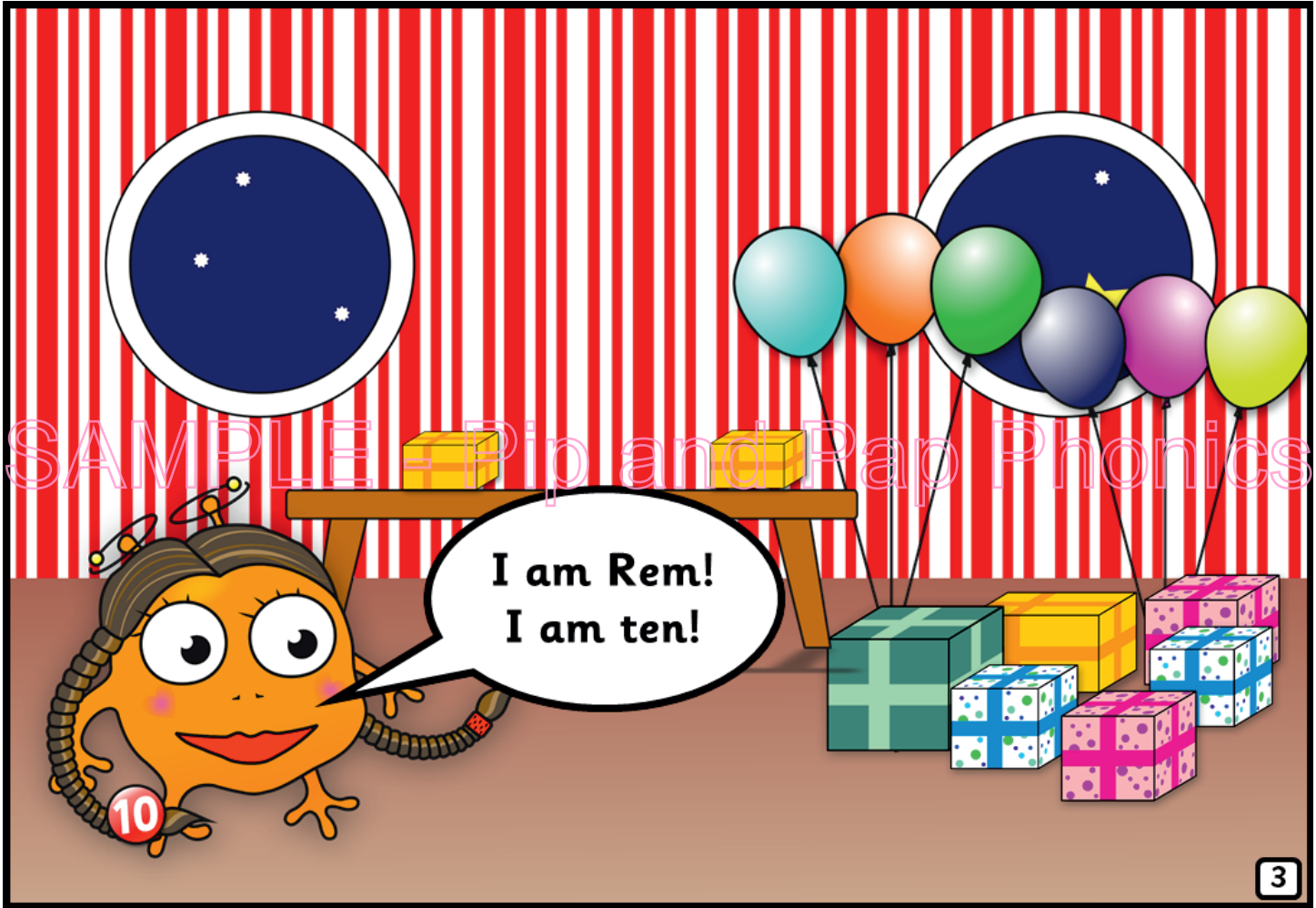


There are some words that cannot be fully sounded out and decoded yet.

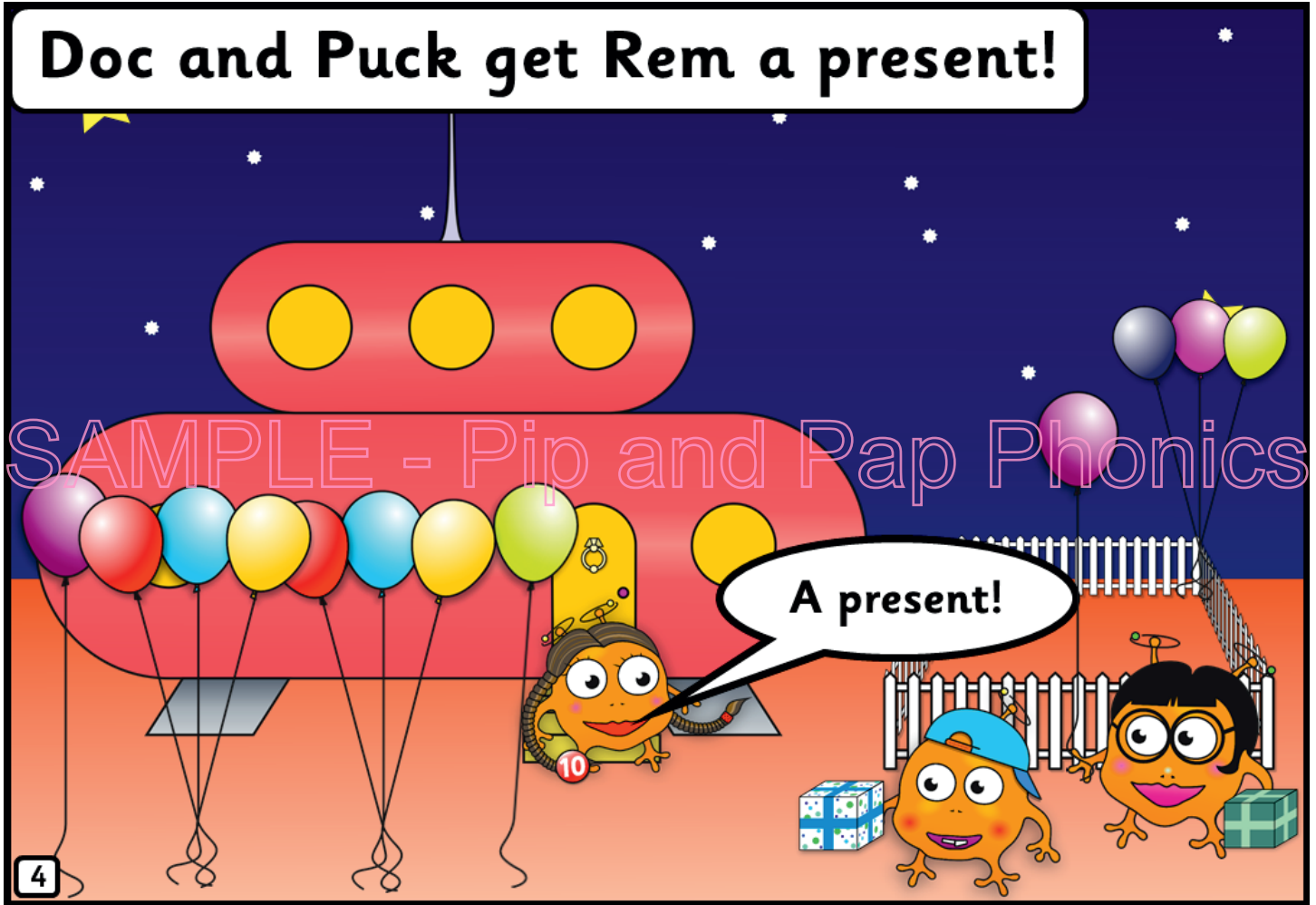


I am Rem!

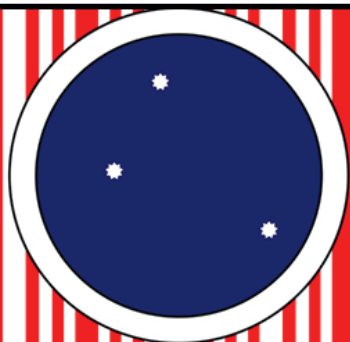

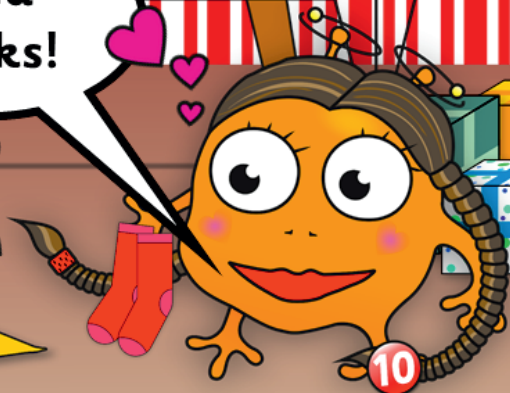


Tisp gets Rem red socks!

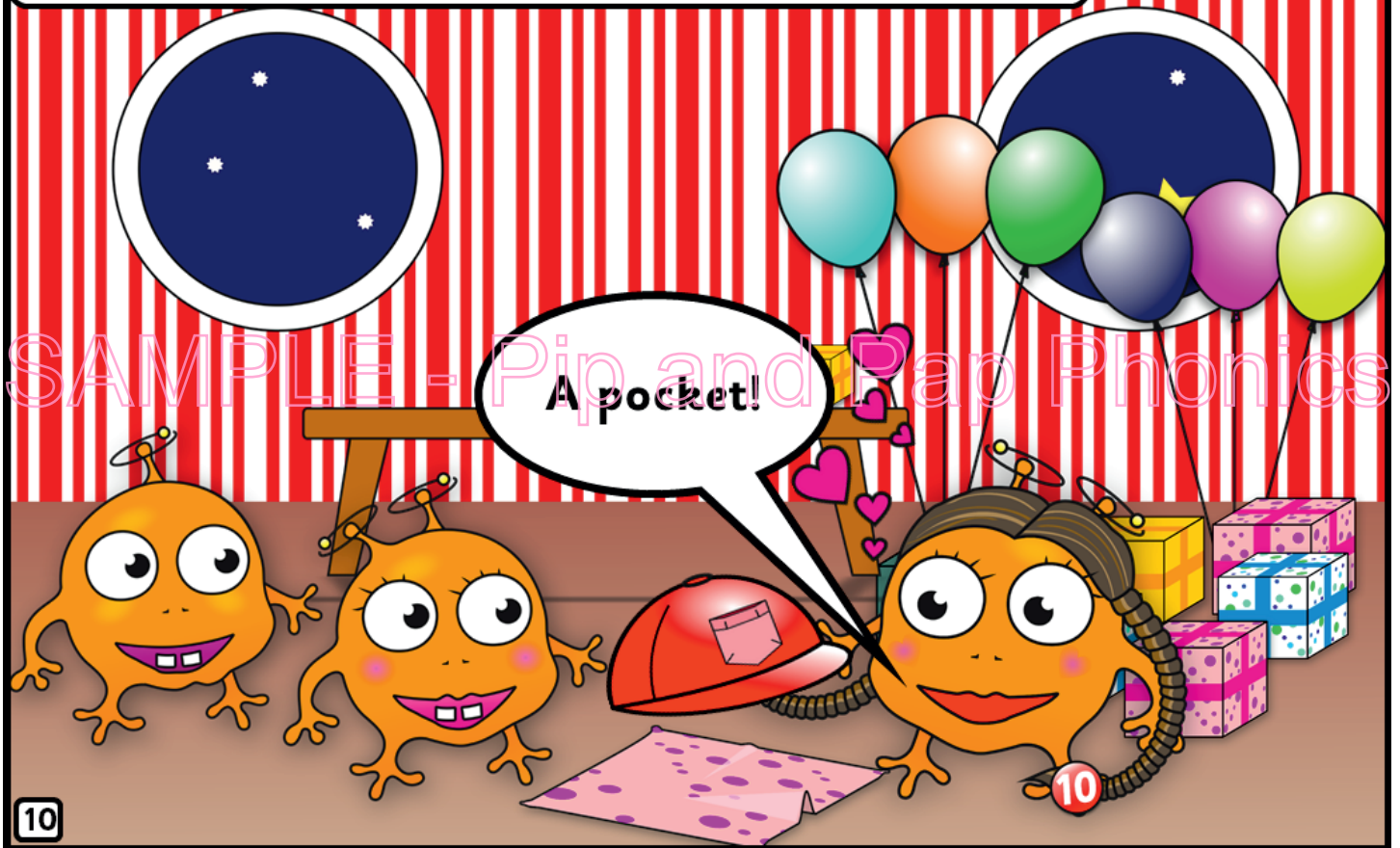

Red socks!

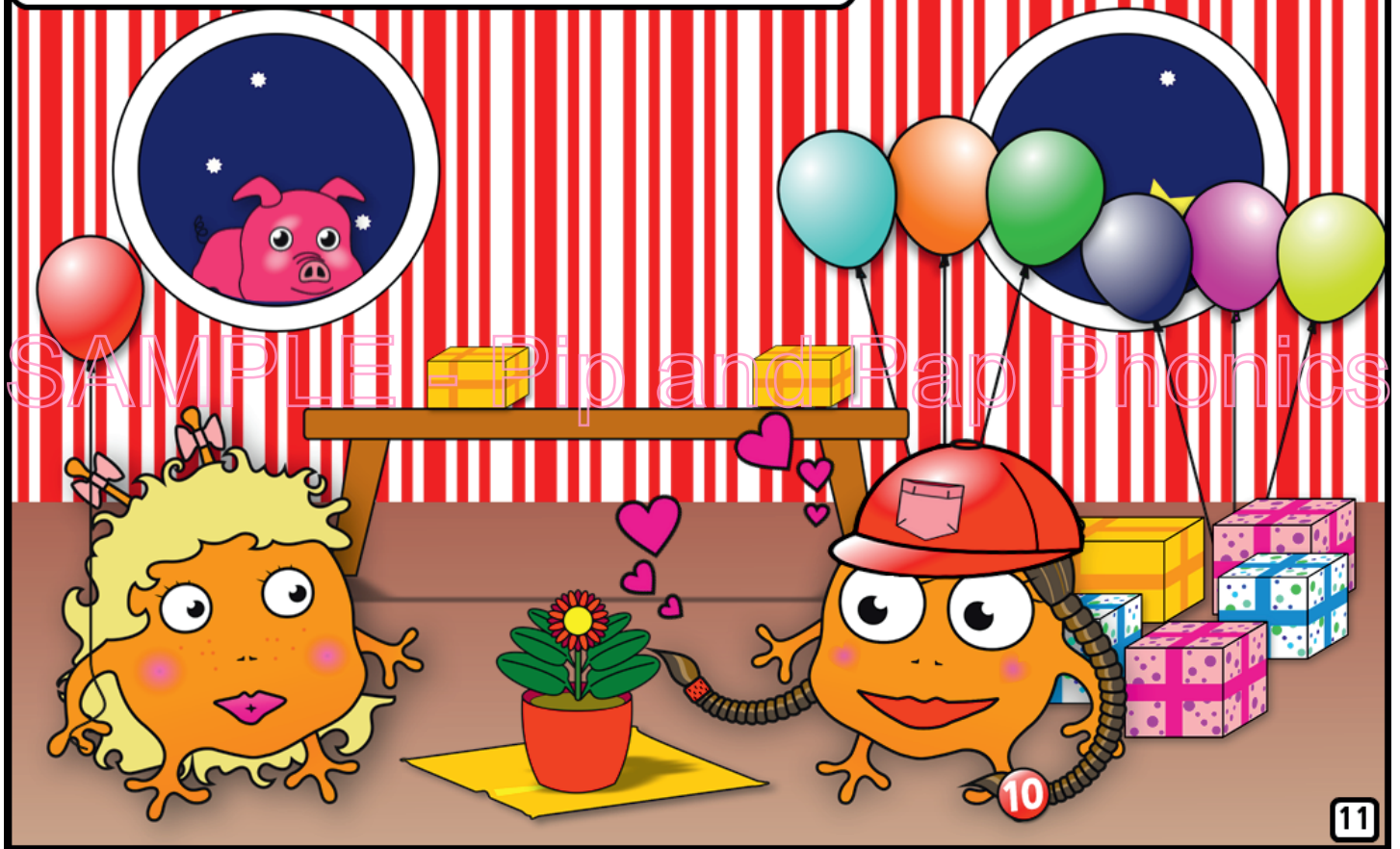


Pip and Pap get Rem a red cap!

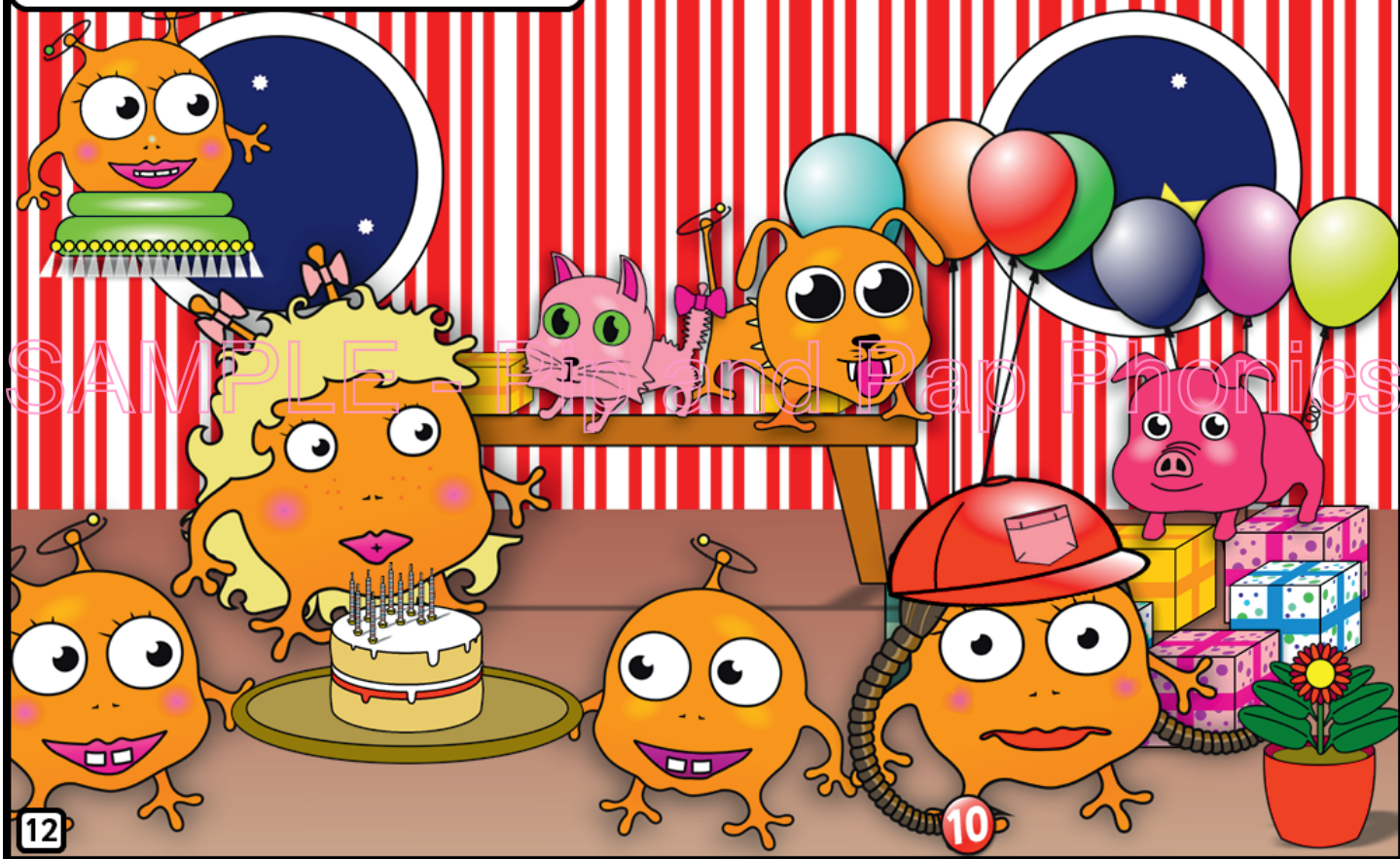

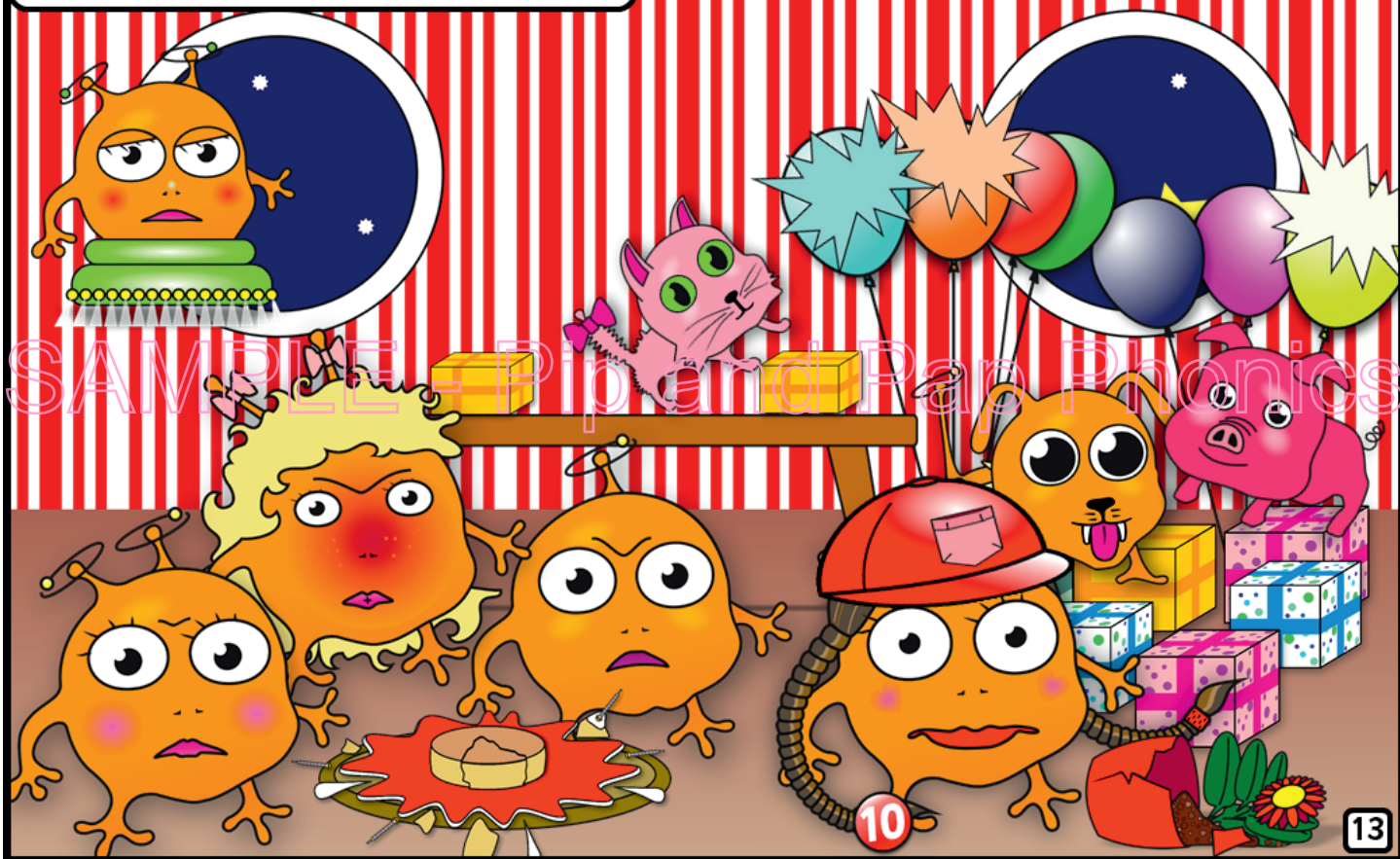
Min gets Rem a red pot.



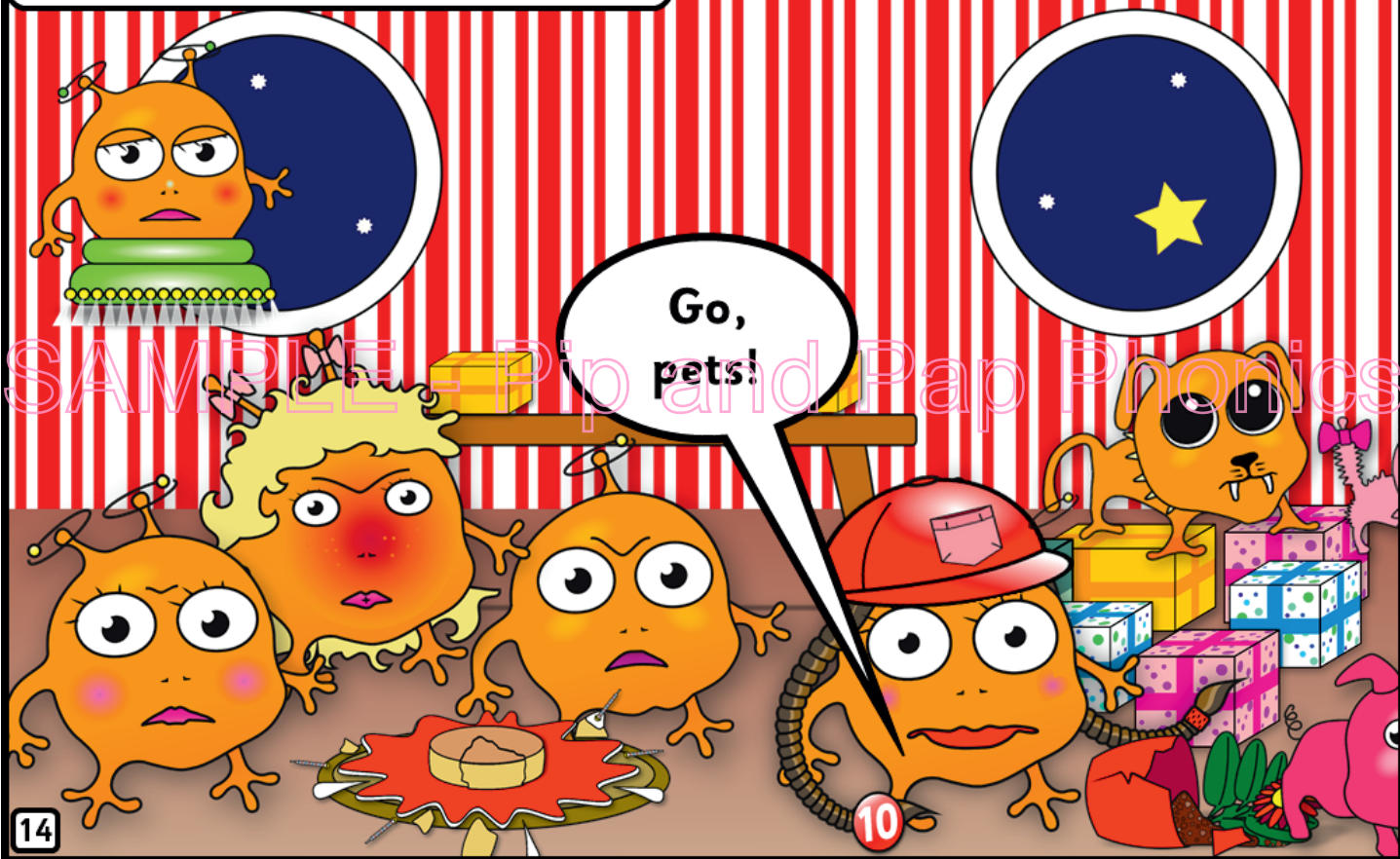
The pets run in!

ages.**

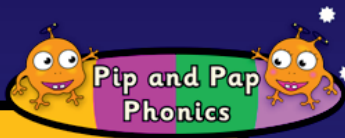
**Do you know the different
