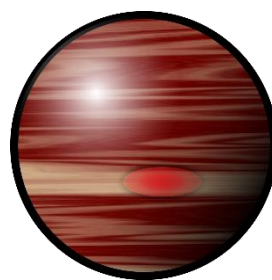
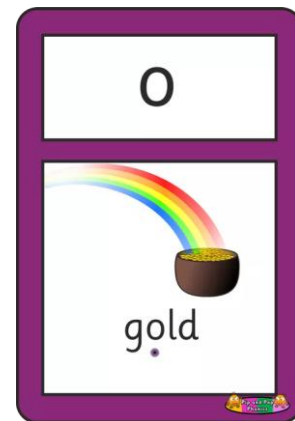

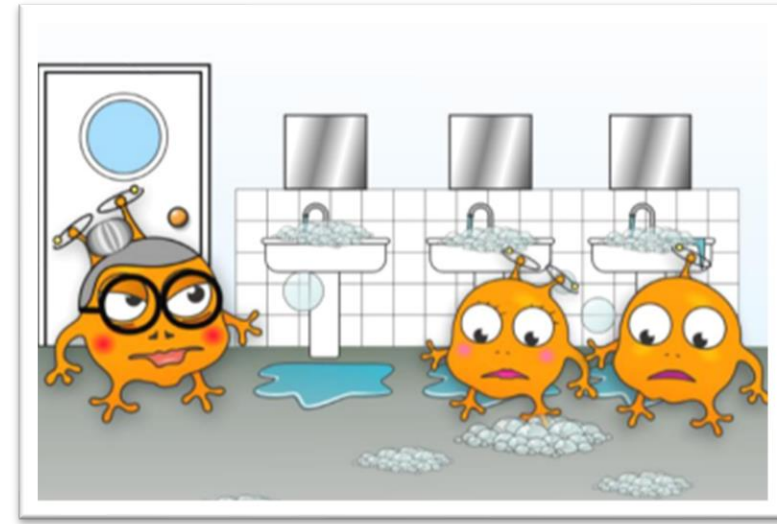
Could you add a sentence to the story that contains a word with the 'o' grapheme, pronounced as /oa/?
